## Media Release

**Incident Date:** 3/16/10

**Incident Time:** 1900hrs

**Incident Location:** Cumberland County Jail

### Incident Synopsis:

On the above date and time, Inmate Ryan Preston (9-27-85), from Harrison, ME, locked his cellmate out of their shared cell during med-pass. Deputy Stewart Corscadden and Corrections Officer Kyle Underwood responded. Preston jumped off his cell bunk and wrapped his arms around Deputy Corscadden. When Officer Underwood attempted to place handcuffs on Preston, he resisted, causing a struggle. After a short struggle, Officer Underwood was able to subdue Preston with Pepper spray.

Deputy Corscadden and Officer Underwood both sustained minor injuries that included bite marks, bumps and bruises. They were treated and released from Maine Medical Center. Inmate Preston is now housed in Maximum Security and reclassified to Hi-Max Status. Preston was serving a 90 day sentence for Criminal Threatening with a Dangerous Weapon. He will likely face new charges stemming from this incident.
