Incident Synopsis:

On Saturday evening at the listed date and time, Cumberland County Sheriff's Deputies and Standish Fire/EMS personnel responded to the 600 block of River Road, in the Town of Standish, on a report of a motor vehicle accident. Initial reports indicated that there were no occupants in the vehicle.

Responding deputies arrived on scene to find that a 1999 Mercury Sedan had left the road after striking several trees. A search of the area revealed that the suspected operator of the vehicle had been ejected and was found laying in a field approximately 25 yards from where the vehicle had come to rest. The subject was found to have sustained life threatening injuries. Standish Fire/EMS personnel treated and transported the victim to Maine Medical Center in Portland.

The victim was identified as:

Mr. Libby was pronounced deceased shortly after arriving at Maine Medical.

Although the investigation is still in its early stages, it appears that speed, alcohol and lack of a seatbelt may have been contributing factors in the accident. This is the second fatal accident in Standish in the past two weekends with what appears to be similar contributing factors.

The Cumberland County Sheriff's Office Accident Reconstruction Team is currently investigating the accident.
