## Press Release April 11, 2010

On Sunday, April 11, 2010 at approximately 4:50 pm, Deputies from the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office and Firefighters from the Standish Fire/Rescue Department responded to a single vehicle motor vehicle crash on the Manchester Road in Standish.

Upon arrival, emergency crews found an Acura Integra in the woods. Further investigation, revealed that the vehicle contained two 17 year old juvenile males, one of which was trapped in the vehicle. Emergency crews were required to extricate the juvenile from the vehicle with serious injuries, but none life threatening to his lower extremities. He was then transported to Maine Medical Center by Lifeflight. The other 17 year old was treated at the scene and released to his parents. Due to the operator and passenger being juveniles, the names will not be released.

Preliminary investigation has determined that the vehicle failed to negotiate a curve, leaving the roadway, and striking several trees. The Cumberland County Sheriff's Office will be reconstructing the accident to determine the exact cause. However, it is believed that speed was involved, and alcohol was not.
