Incident Synopsis:

At approximately 20:30 hours this evening, a vehicle traveling northbound on the Oak Hill Rd. in Standish struck a 500 pound bull moose which walked out into the roadway in front of the vehicle.

The vehicle, a 1997 Chevrolet Lumina was being operated by Justin Webster, 31 years of age from Portland. Mr. Webster had to be extricated from the vehicle by Standish Fire and Rescue. Mr. Webster was transported by Standish Rescue to the Maine Medical Center with serious life threatening injuries.

A passenger, Jessica Rickman 21 years of age from Limington was also transported by Standish Rescue to the Maine Medical Center for non life threatening injuries.

The moose was killed as a result of the crash.
