Media Release

Incident Date: May 17, 2010
Incident Time: 21:20Hours
Incident Location: Northeast Rd. Standish

Incident Synopsis:

On the above date and time, a deputy from the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office attempted to stop a vehicle that was being operated erratically on the Northeast Rd. (Rte 35) in Standish.

When the deputy activated his emergency lights, the operator pulled over as if he were going to stop, but then drove off. As the vehicle sped off, the operator crossed Rte. 25 and hit a vehicle driving through the intersection of Northeast Rd. and Rte. 25. The suspect vehicle traveled along the Bonny Eagle Rd. (Rte 35), proceeded along Rte 22 through Buxton and then the operator proceeded to drive into a field on the Plains Rd. in Hollis. The operator lost control of his vehicle in the field and became in operable. The male operator fled on foot leaving a male passenger in the vehicle.

A K-9 Team from the Windham Police Department was called to conduct a track as deputies from the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office, Gorham Police Department and the Buxton Police Department set up a perimeter. The operator of the vehicle was located by the K-9 Team in the wooded area adjacent to the field where the vehicle was disabled.

The operator, 24 year old Sean Latham, from Hollis, was arrested and charged with eluding a police officer, operating under the influence, operating after revocation (habitual offender) and violating a condition of release (on a previous theft arrest).

The passenger, 22 year old Kyle Goding, from Bangor, was arrested on an outstanding warrant and charged with violating conditions of release (on a previous drug arrest).

The vehicle struck at the intersection of Rte 25 and Rte 35, was a 2000 Jeep Cherokee being operated by 26 year old Jennifer Wilcox from Standish. She was not hurt. Her vehicle sustained \$2,000.00 worth of damage.
