Incident Synopsis:

On Friday morning at approximately 07:33 hours, a student from Gray Middle School allegedly made reference to a bomb being placed on one of Gray's school busses. The bus was on the road at the time the threat was communicated and was transporting students in the area of Route 202 and Lawrence Road, in the Town of Gray.

The bus operator was notified of the threat and immediately pulled the bus off the road and evacuated all students. The student involved in the threat was not on the bus at the time the threat was communicated.

Deputies from the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office responded to the incident and closed off the immediate area. A Bomb Detection K-9 from the Portland Police Department responded to the scene and searched the bus and immediate area for any explosive devices, finding none. The area of Route 202 and Lawrence Road was shut down for approximately one hour during the incident.

The involved student's identity is being withheld at this time due to the subject being a juvenile. The student was summons on the charge of a "False Public alarm or Report" and released to a guardian pending prosecution.
