Incident Synopsis:

At approximately 9:16PM last night, deputies from the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office responded to the Basin Point Rd in Harpswell to investigate a report of a home invasion .

Upon their arrival, deputies found that a young male subject wearing a ski mask and armed with a knife had forced his way into a residence occupied by a 77 year old female and stole her medications, namely oxycontin. During the incident, the victim was knocked to the floor and sustained a small laceration to a finger when her hand made contact with the knife that the suspect was carrying.

The 77 year old victim was transported to Parkview Hospital by the Harpswell Neck Rescue, where she was treated for the laceration.

Deputies from the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office and Police Officers from the Brunswick Police Department responded and set up a perimeter until a Sheriff's Office K-9 unit could arrive and begin a track of the suspect.

The name of the victim is being withheld for investigatory purposes, for the time being.
