Media Release UPDATE

Incident Date: June 16, 2010
Incident Time: 1:59 pm
Incident Location: Ossipee Trail East, Standish

Incident Synopsis:

On the above date and time, Cumberland County Sheriff's Deputies responded to a two car accident on Ossipee Trail East (Route 25) in Standish. 63-year-old Paula Haddow from Standish was driving a 2010 Toyota Tacoma West on Ossipee Trail East when she crossed into the east bound lane and hit a 2005 Hyundai Elantra operated by 57-year-old Marilyn McClendon of South Portland. The Toyota rolled end to end before coming to rest. Haddow was not hurt and refused medical treatment.

McClendon and the other four occupants of her vehicle (names listed below) were hurt, one critically and transported to Maine Medical Center in Portland by Standish and Gorham EMS.

The four occupants are all from Tennessee, in Maine attending a Baptist retreat.

Palmer Maphet, 20-year-old male	(DECEASED)
Lea Hardwick, 20-year-old female	(Non-life threatening)
Legon Craighead, 19-year-old female	(Non-life threatening)
Justin Owens, 20-year-old male	(Non-life threatening)

The Cumberland County Reconstruction Team is currently on scene beginning their investigation into the cause of this crash.

Maine Medical Center advised the Sheriff's Office at 8:00 PM the Palmer Maphet succumbed to injuries and died.
