Incident Synopsis:

On the above date and time Deputy Sherry Sewell of the Sheriff's Office was on duty operating her cruiser east on White's Bridge Road in Standish. She observed a Black 2001 Lexus IS300, operating in her direction at a high rate of speed traveling west towards 302. The vehicle was partially in her travel lane causing her to take evasive maneuvers to avoid a crash. She turned on the vehicle and found that it crashed at the intersection of Leisure Point. The operator and only occupant of the vehicle:

Of: 157 White's Bridge Rd. Standish

Standish Rescue transported the operator to Maine Medical for a head injury. The accident is still under investigation and is being reconstructed. Initial investigation shows that alcohol, speed and failure to wear seatbelt are all factors in the accident and injuries; the vehicle was totaled in the accident.
