Incident:

On Friday morning at 02:46 hours, Deputies from the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office responded to 54 Northern Oaks Drive, in the Town of Gray, on a reported burglary in progress. The victims of the burglary were asleep in the residence when they were awoken by an unknown male holding a flashlight and standing in their bedroom. When confronted, the suspect fled and was chased from the residence by the owner. The suspect entered a vehicle that was parked close by and fled the scene. Upon returning to the residence the victims noticed that many of their belongings had been stacked near the entrance to the residence in preparation to be removed by the suspect.

Responding deputies canvassed the area and found what appeared to be skid marks in the roadway not far from the incident scene. Further investigation revealed that a vehicle had recently gone off the road but had fled the scene. As deputies continued to check the area they were able to locate a vehicle that fit the description provided by the victims. The vehicle also had evidence of being recently operated as well as debris on the vehicle consistent with one that had left the road.

Deputies checked on the registered owner and found that the owner, (Ryan P. Fogg) was wanted on a Burglary/Theft warrant out of Portland. Their investigation led them to a residence at 130 Lyons Point Road where Deputies spoke with a male subject through a door. That individual was identified as Ryan P. Fogg, DOB: 11/06/1986. When ordered to come out of the residence, Mr. Fogg refused and barricaded he and his girlfriend, Cara J. Deviod, DOB: 03/29/1988, inside the residence.

Several additional deputies responded to the scene including the Sheriff's Office Emergency Services Team Negotiators. After several hours of negotiations Ms.

Devoid vacated the residence. At 07:27 hours Mr. Fogg surrendered without incident. Sheriff's Office Detectives obtained a search warrant for the residence and upon conducting the search, Detectives were able to locate items that connected Mr. Fogg to the burglary crime scene.

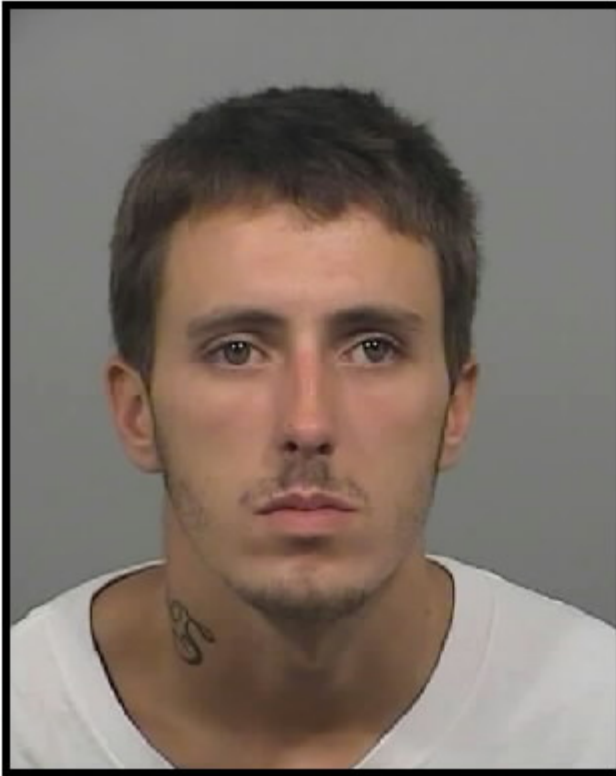
Ryan Fogg has an extensive criminal history involving burglaries, theft, and drugs. He has been transported to the Cumberland County jail where he was charged with the original Portland warrant and a new charge of burglary/theft class-B.
