### Incident Synopsis:

At approximately 5:30 AM today, the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office responded to a residence on Hawthorne Road in Raymond to investigate a stolen motor vehicle complaint on a 2006 Toyota Camary.

Sgt. Al Winslow responded to the residence and met with the complainant, took a theft of a motor vehicle report and put out a teletype state wide for an attempt to locate the stolen vehicle.

A short time later, Sgt. Winslow observed the stolen vehicle with two male occupants traveling on the Spiller Hill Road in Raymond. When Sgt. Winslow proceeded to stop the suspect vehicle, the driver pulled over and the occupants fled on foot. Sgt. Winslow and his K-9 partner, Jag, chased the suspects on foot and apprehended them a short distance into the woods.

A subsequent investigation revealed that the suspects not only had stolen a vehicle, but had committed several burglaries to motor vehicles and thefts in the Raymond area.

Both suspects, who are juveniles (ages 15 and 16), were arrested and processed at the Cumberland County Jail and then released to their parents with conditions of release. The suspects will be charged with Unauthorized Use of a Motor Vehicle, Burglary to a Motor Vehicle and Theft. The operator of the stolen vehicle was also charged with Operating without a License.
