Media Release Updated

Incident Date: 08/29/2010
Incident Time: 1:14 AM
Incident Location: Poland Spring Rd (Route 11) area of 1000
known as Rye Field Flats in Casco.

Incident Synopsis: On the above date and time, a Deputy Sheriff was attempting to stop a vehicle that was traveling at a high rate of speed with any driving lights north on the Poland Spring Rd. (Route 11) coming from the area of Rt. 302. The vehicle did initially pull over after about a mile but took back off at a high rate of speed; the operator continued out of sight of the Deputy for traveling about another 2 miles down the road where it was found crashed into the some trees just off the roadway (area known as Rye Field Flats).

Both Casco and Naples Fire/Rescue responded to the accident. The two male passengers (one juvenile, one adult) were confirmed deceased at the scene; the adult male operator was taken to Central Maine Medical Center in Lewiston by Life Flight.

No names are being released at this time until next of kin of the deceased are notified.

The accident is being Re-Constructed and will remain under investigation. At this time no charges have been filed against the driver.

Update: The names of the three males involved in the accident are:

1. **Nicholas Sparrow**, 20 years old of Rosewood St. in Casco, Me. He was the driver and remains at Central Maine Medical Center.
2. **Thomas St. Saviour**, 29 years old of Amy Circle in Hiram, Me. He was a passenger in the car and was killed from the accident.

3. **Juvenile male**, 14 years old of Baldwin, Me. He was a passenger in the car and was killed from the accident.

The vehicle involved was a white 1993 Infinity registered to Sparrow's girlfriend.
