### **Press Release** **July 20, 2007**

On July 14, 2007 at around 5:30 p.m. the Sheriff's Office initiated an investigation into the assault of an 11 year-old girl that had occurred at the Sebago Lake State Park Campground Beach.

The girl, a resident of Windham, while camping with her family at the state park was swimming with a friend in a somewhat remote area of the state park beach.

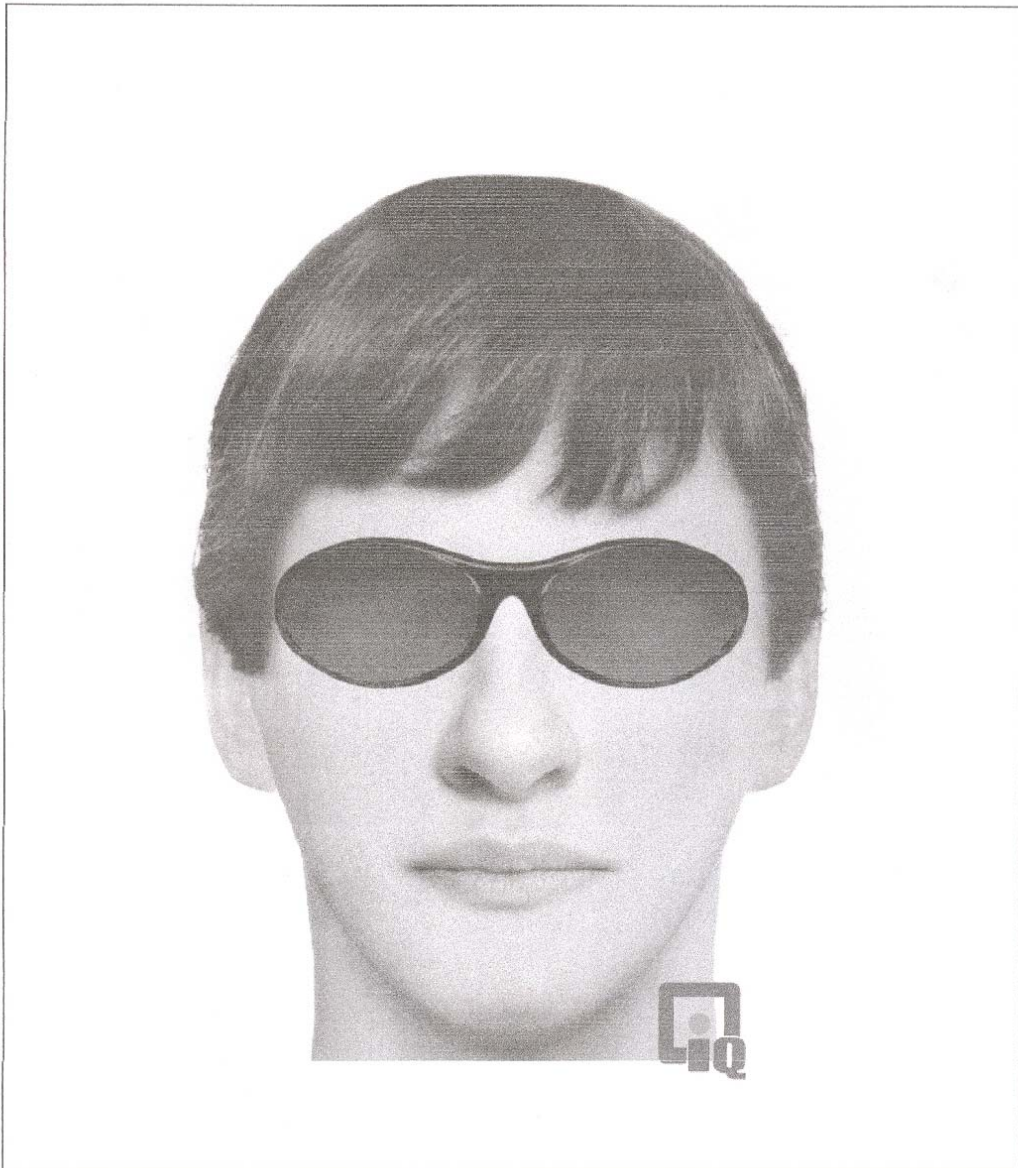
The suspect had a boat tied to a tree in the area and was swimming. The suspect physically grabbed the girl and caused her to touch him in an inappropriate manner.

The suspect is described as a white male being in his forties between 5'04" and 6'00" in height, having short, straight dark hair and was wearing sport-style black sunglasses, a bright yellow lifejacket with a black zipper, blue shorts and black Teva sandals.

The suspect's boat is described as an inflatable Zodiac-style boat, green in color being 10 to 12 feet in length with a black Mercury motor attached and displaying white lettering or numbers.
