After working through the night and into the morning hours, members of the Sheriff's Office tracked down and arrested the two individuals who were involved in the attempted Robbery of the Puffin Stop convenience store located in Gray square.

Arrested at 2am on 10/31/2007, after a Sheriff's Deputy saw the vehicle in the Shaw's parking lot in Windham and stopped it, were:

1. Megan E. Reeves, 19 years old
LKA/ 15 Misty Drive Windham, ME

And,

2. Christopher W. Poulack, 29 years old
LKA/ 148 Sandbar Rd. Windham, ME

Reeves was charged with, Robbery, Class A and Violation of Conditions of Release. Reeves is being held without Bail, at CCJ pending a court appearance later this week (Thursday).

Poulak was charged with, Robbery, Class A, OUI, OAS, Possession of Firearm by a Felon and Trafficking in Dangerous Knives. He is being held at CCJ on \$100,000/cash bail. He will be arraigned later this week (Thursday).

The case will be presented to the District Attorney's Office for review and possibly additional or elevating the current charges.

Reeves has been involved in numerous crimes over the last several months both in Maine and out-of-state.
