



PRESS RELEASE

At approximately 11:30 a.m. an altercation between two inmates erupted in the recreation area of the maximum security housing unit within the Cumberland County Jail. Federal inmate Robert Riffey, DOB 3-24-70 and State detainee, Terrell Dubois, DOB 7-4-84 were involved.

The fracas began as a result of a racial slur directed against Dubois by Riffey. Dubois retaliated by stabbing Riffey near the right collar bone with a wooden pencil. Riffey was treated for a puncture wound by jail medical staff. The injury to Riffey is not life threatening.

The incident is currently under investigation by the Sheriff's Office. The U.S. Marshal's Office has been notified of the incident.
