The Cumberland County Sheriff's Office is investigating a motorcycle crash that occurred at approximately 14:50 hours today, on the Bonny Eagle Rd. in Standish.

A 1996 Harley Davidson motorcycle was traveling northbound on the Bonny Eagle Rd., when a 1986 Subaru Legacy traveling southbound on the Bonny Eagle Rd., made a left hand turn into a driveway in front of the oncoming motorcycle. The operator of the motorcycle was able to avoid the vehicle but in doing so lost control and "laid" the motorcycle down in the roadway.

The operator of the motorcycle, Alan Arnott, 51 years of age from Windham, was transported to the Maine Medical Center by Standish Rescue. Mr. Arnott was not wearing a helmet and his injuries included broken bones. The passenger, Kathie Watts 53 years of age from Windham, was also transported to the Maine Medical Center where she was being treated for head injuries. Ms. Watts was also not wearing a helmet.

The operator of the Subaru, Karey Moreau age 36 from Standish, was not injured.

Accident Re-Constructionists from the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office are investigating the crash.
