On Wednesday, March 11, 2009, at approximately 14:10 hours Deputies from the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office responded to a reported bank robbery at the Gorham Savings Bank in Standish. The bank is located at the Colonial Market Place on Ossipee Trail.

The suspect entered the bank and passed a teller a note demanding money. The suspect told the teller that he had a firearm, however, none was displayed during the incident. The suspect obtained an undisclosed amount of money and then fled the scene on foot, last observed walking west on Route 25 towards Standish Corner. It is believed that the suspect may have entered a vehicle at some point but information on a suspect vehicle is still being obtained by CCSO Detectives.

The suspect is described as being a white male, 35-40 years of age, 5'6" to 5'8", 150 to 170 pounds, ruddy complexion, short graying hair, wearing a black leather coat with a black hoodie, Ralph Lauren Jeans, and oval shaped sun glasses.

CCSO Detectives are currently reviewing bank video footage and interviewing several witnesses in an attempt to identify the suspect(s) involved in the incident.
