## Press Release

On Sunday evening, May 10th, at approximately 8:15 pm, the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office and Standish Rescue was dispatched to a disturbance at 3 Crestwood Drive in Standish.

Upon their arrival, they discovered that 33 year old Christopher Cook had sustained multiple stab wounds to his lower and upper extremities. Standish Rescue immediately provided medical treatment due to the substantial blood loss and was transported Maine Medical Center in Portland. He is in stable condition, with non-life threatening injuries. Additionally, 29 year old Tanya Ennis sustained several contusions and abrasions to her head and body, but was not transported to the hospital.

At this time, the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office and Cumberland County District Attorney's Office are determining if charges will be filed. They however, have preliminarily determined that this disturbance call and assault was domestic violence related. Further, interviews and follow up will be taking place later on today.
