The Sheriff's Office arrested and charged the following individual in a residential Burglary (apartment) that occurred on Dyer's Cove Road in Harpswell sometime between May 19-26 while the homeowner was away on vacation:

1. Kevin G. Neugebauer DOB: 01/06/1988 of 3030 North Deer Run, Carson City, Nevada.

Deputies arrested Neugebauer on June 1st, and charged him with: Burglary (Class B) and Theft (Class C). He is also currently on probation with the State of Nevada for a prior residential Burglary and is failing to legally have his probation transferred to Maine (Maine refused).

Neugebauer was in Maine visiting his sister and staying in her apartment in the same complex as the victim's.

The arrest was made as a result of Sagadahoc County Sheriff's Detectives investigating burglaries in their jurisdiction in which Neugebauer was a suspect. The Detectives had located several of the stolen items (jewelry) from the Dyer's Cove Rd Burglary, at a local pawn shop in Brunswick.

Neugebauer is currently at the Maine Correctional Center (MCC) in Windham, pending a trial date which is yet to be set. Booking photo can be obtained through the CCJ-Intake at 774.1444 ext. 2141.
