The Cumberland County Sheriff's Office conducted a license checkpoint on Rte 302 in Raymond this evening between the hours of 5:30PM-9:30PM. During this four hour period, 427 operators were checked. As a result, two operators were arrested and charged with operating after suspension.

- Steven Young, 25 years of age from Portland was arrested and charged with operating after suspension.
- Robert Bailey, 46 years of age from Harrison, was arrested and charged with operating after suspension and illegal attachment of registration plates. Mr. Bailey also had two outstanding warrants for failure to pay fine for OAS and failure to appear for OAS.

A third operator, John Shanahan 28 years of age from Gray, was arrested and charged with illegal possession of a scheduled drug (methadone) a class D crime and possession of a usable amount of marijuana (civil violation).

Also, there were thirty warnings given for various motor vehicle violations including un-inspected motor vehicles, loud exhaust etc.

This effort is part of an ongoing campaign to keep habitual offenders and suspended drivers off Maine's roadways.
