



PRESS RELEASE

At approximately 5:05PM this evening, the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office investigated a motor vehicle accident that occurred on the Blake Rd. in Standish.

A 2004 Mitsubishi Gallant was traveling northbound on the Blake Rd. in Standish when the operator failed to negotiate a curve, skidded and struck a tree.

The operator of the Danielle Walker 23 years of age from Windham was treated and released at the scene by Standish Rescue for a minor leg injury.

A passenger in the vehicle, Jeremy Barton 26 years of age, from Westerly, Rhode Island was transported to the Maine Medical Center by Standish Rescue with serious head trauma. Mr. Barton is in stable condition

It appears that speed and alcohol may have been a factor in the accident.
