Press Release July 21, 2009

On Monday, July 20th, at approximately 09:35 hours, Deputies from the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office responded to a report of suspicious activity in the area of 753 Edes Falls Road, in the Town of Harrison. The complainant reported that four males were near an unoccupied residence. Three of the males had gone to the rear of the address while the fourth stayed in the front and acted as a look out.

The responding Deputies located the 4 subjects carrying back packs. Upon checking the residence in question, the Deputies found that a window to the rear of the address had been damaged allowing the suspects to gain entry to the residence. It appears that nothing had been removed from the residence and the subjects may have been startled by an area resident.

Three juveniles, ages 15 (2) and 17 and an 18 year old male were charged with burglary/criminal mischief. The juveniles were summonsed and released to the custody of their parents. The 18 year old has been identified as Joseph Cash, a resident of 660 Edes Falls Road, in Harrison. Cash was also charged in the incident.
