On Wednesday, September 16, 2009, at approximately 21:24 hours; Cumberland County Sheriff's Deputies responded to the area of 341 Tenney Hill Road, in the Town of Casco, on a report of a male who had been stabbed. The caller reported that the male was walking on the side of the road armed with a knife and was bleeding from a stab wound.

As Deputies arrived on scene they observed the male run into a wooded area near 341 Tenney Hill. As the Deputies approached the subject, he brandished the knife holding them at bay. The subject then placed the knife to his throat and threatened to kill himself. It appeared that the subject had already stabbed himself several times.

As Deputies attempted to negotiate with the subject he began to cut into his own neck with the knife. Deputies Mathew Tufts and Steven Welsh deployed their Tasers at the male and were able to disarm him. The subject was identified as being Kenneth K. Brown, DOB: 02/24/1987 of 25 Mill Lane, in Naples. Mr. Brown was transported to the Maine Medical Center in Portland where he is currently undergoing treatment for non life threatening injuries. The Two responding Deputies were not injured in the incident. There are no charges pending at this time.
