On Saturday, 04/11/09, at 2338 hours, Deputies from the Cumberland County Sheriff's Office responded to the Gilman Hill Road in the Town of Baldwin for a reported Stabbing.

Responding Deputies were informed that the victim was at a party in a gravel pit and had been stabbed in the upper leg. The victim is identified as Ryan Morrell, (DOB 05/26/86), a resident of Standish. Mr. Morrell was transported via private vehicle to the area of RT 11 and RT 114 in Sebago where he was treated by Sebago Rescue personnel. Mr. Morrell told deputies that he had been stabbed by an unknown male while at the party for no apparent reason.

Mr. Morrell was transported to Bridgton Hospital where was stabilized and later transferred to a CMMC where he is currently listed in stable condition.

The suspect, a juvenile, was located at his residence in Buxton by the Buxton Police Department. The juvenile was arrested on an outstanding arrest warrant by Buxton PD. The juvenile was uncooperative with Sheriff's deputies during the follow up investigation. The juvenile was charged with elevated Aggravated Assault and transported to the Long Creek Detention Center.
