On Wednesday, 01/20/2010, at approximately 20:56 hours, Cumberland County Sheriff's Deputies responded to the area of 817 Anderson Road, in the Town of Sebago, on a report of suspicious activity taking place. Upon arrival, the deputies located a dirt bike and a chainsaw in the fresh snow near an unoccupied residence.

The deputies observed foot prints in the snow and started a track that led them to a couple of summer residences that had been forcibly entered. Upon speaking with the owner of one of the homes, the deputies were able to determine that the chain saw was stolen in the burglary from his residence.

Sheriff's Deputies were able to track the suspect on foot in the snow for approximately one half mile and were successful in locating the suspect who attempted to secrete himself by lying down in a wooded area.

The suspect was identified as Nicholas T. Sparrow, DOB: 04/24/1990, a resident of 10 Wadley Street in Parsonsfield, Maine. Mr. Sparrow was placed under arrest without incident and transported to the Cumberland County Jail and charged with Burglary, Theft and Criminal Mischief.
